	Construction Agreement and other documents as necessary for the seismic retrofit and upgrades to Sheridan's main station.  Cooley says the board President is typically given the authorization to sign. Bottenberg says "I would amend my motion as such."  Amended Motion  Motion: Bottenberg Second: Breeden  I move to accept the bids as presented, accept and issue Notice of Intent to Award to DSL Construction as the lowest bidder and give the Board President permission to issue the Notice of Award, negotiate, sign, and execute the Construction Agreement and other documents as necessary for the seismic retrofit and upgrades to Sheridan's main station.
